The August SJCC Board Meeting was held at Denny's Restaurant at 2077 North First Street, San Jose. The meeting was called to order at 7:35 PM with 11 seated members and 2 guests, **Fred Davis** and **Ron Ishizaki** present. Recording Secretary,

Allison Paker read the minutes from the August 9 General Meeting which were corrected and approved. **Treasurer, Larry Benson** read his treasurer's report. **Membership Chair, Ed Sins** turned in \$85 for dues and reported that notices were sent out to members who were delinquent in their dues. He also gave

Newsletter Editor, Ray Johnson the names of those who were to be dropped from the mail out list. **Old Business** - None

New Business - **Larry Benson** received a flier about a theft of silver bars in Long Beach. There is a \$500,000 reward. **Member, John Jencek** will be borrowing display cases again for his ancient coin show.

Member, Don Cracraft, our current webmaster, would like to give up his position. There was discussion of who would like to take over the position. No volunteer came forth. The question was raised if we needed more Capital Plastic holders. **Ray** will look into it.

Show Business - A complaint was received by **Bourse Chairs, Jo** and **John Sarti** that the Crowne Plaza is not honoring the discount rate for king-size beds. For a king-size bed, go to the Hilton. **Jo** also reported that 21 bourse apps. have been received.

Some are interested in participating in youth activities and some would like to advertise in the show program. If needed, advertisements from last year's program may be used for this year's program. **Advertising Chair, Ken Barr** has put in a request for gray sheet advertising and a Coin World ad is being sent in. A question was raised if all the advertising is paying off and if the postcard mail-out is cost effective. **Historian, Sally Johnson** suggested putting computer terminals at the show where people can enter their email addresses, creating a big database for future advertising. **Jo Sarti** will try to attend upcoming shows to leave fliers for San Jose's January show. It was requested to get the dates for the 2008 show set for advertising purposes and to let the dealers know when the show will be.

Ron Ishizaki is the CSNA Chairman for the upcoming meeting at the January show. There will be a CSNA banquet at the Crowne Plaza on Saturday the 13th at 7pm. The price for members is \$34 and \$36 for non-members. Awards will be presented at the banquet. **Ron** made a suggestion that in order to encourage more displays at the show, the San Jose Coin Club give \$5 towards each exhibitors dinner at the banquet. A heated discussion followed with the main opposing view of not wanting to reward non-San Jose Coin Club members for a non-San Jose Coin Club event. **Ken Barr** had an idea and motioned to give a \$5 voucher to each exhibitor for the banquet of their choice- either to the CSNA in January or SJCC in April.
