Recording Secretary, Allison Paker** read the minutes from the November 8, 2006 General Meeting which were approved as read. **Curator, Ken Barr** reported he has some new tokens & medals & two items donated by **Don Barsi. Youth Advisor, Sally Johnson** has stockings for the Christmas meeting. **Don Barsi & Chuck Call** have donated items for the youth stockings. **Treasurer, Larry Benson** gave his treasurer's Report. **Membership Chair, Ed Sins** reported we have four new members; **Jerry Gaither** and **Rich Medefesser**, and youths **Michael & Lauren Shusterman. Librarian, Ed Sins** has put in a request for a new book on US currency. **Program**

Chair, Patricia Russ says program speakers are booked through 2007 except September.

OLD BUSINESS:

A suggestion was made to have ribbons as prizes instead of trophies for our show's exhibits. A second suggestion was made to make the exhibits non-competitive and just give participation medals. Much discussion followed but it was decided to table the ideas until next year and leave everything the same for the 2007 show. It was reported that CSNA & the Exnumia Society will be judging exhibits this year also.

SHOW BUSINESS:

72 dealers have signed up. We have \$30,000 in bourse fees. There are two stamp dealers and maybe three collectibles dealers. King sized beds at the Crowne Plaza should now be available. Peggy Sue's would like the same ad in the show program. **General Show Chair, Patricia Russ** has news about the 2008 dates. We wanted the show to be January 18, 19 & 20, but the Tech Museum will be using Parkside Hall from September 2007 to January 2008. We have been offered Southside Hall which is known as "The Tent." It is not really a tent. It has 80,000 square feet, and is located between Market & Almaden behind the Convention Center. We would have to move the show to February 1, 2, & 3. With the extra space, it would be possible to add a collectibles extension and maybe an antique car show. Parking would be the same. **Patricia** has looked for other possible places in Santa Clara County big enough for our show. After some discussion, a consensus was reached that we should try to get a space at the Santa Clara Convention Center. **Larry Benson** motioned that we should look into booking Santa Clara for January 18-20, but if that will not work we book the Southside Hall for the February dates. The motion was seconded and passed. Last year we made \$40,000 in bourse fees. Right now we have brought in \$30,000. **Alan Douglass & Lee Wilson** will be meeting to discuss security for the show. The price should be the same. **Sally Johnson, Patricia Russ, & Larry Benson** will meet to check out the Southside Hall. **Jo Sarti** will pick up the postcards Wednesday. **Larry Benson** will bring the stamps to the December meeting.
