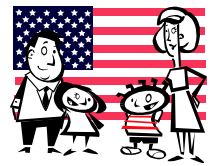

And then there are those members of our own club who sit on the side lines and snipe at our efforts.

We have always put on an outstanding show. This club show has always gotten high marks for being a dealer friendly and well organized club show. We want to keep that reputation and show our dealers and visitors that the San Jose Coin, Stamp and Collectibles Show will always maintain high standards and provide them with a great place to buy and sell.

We need the help of all of our members to put on this show. We all had to start somewhere. We hope you will consider stepping up and volunteering for one of the many tasks necessary to provide another great show.  - Youth Treasure Hunt - hand out Treasure Hunt materials, instruct kids on how it works
