### AT THE SEP. 12<sup>TH</sup> GENERAL MEETING

The September 12, 2007 General Meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by **President, Fred Davis**. There were 44 members and 2 guests (**Bob Boesel and Darlene Thorne**) in attendance. **Auctioneer, Ken Barr** called the Auction with **Auction Chair, Richard Boston** assisting and **Vice President, Ryan Johnson** acting as runner. **Fred** announced that **Member, Bill Higgins** purchased the September meeting raffle prizes. **Bill Higgins** announced that he had Santa Cruz Coin Club raffle tickets for sale. **Treasurer, Ray Johnson** announced that he has Capital Plastics holders for six 39MM medals for sale at \$17.50 each. **Board Member, Lyle Okamoto** introduced:

**Dr. David Goya** was the featured speaker. His talk was on 'Minerva's Owl: The Commemorative Coins of the Panama-Pacific International Exposition of 1915'.

Minutes were approved as they were printed in the newsletter.

**OLD BUSINESS: Medals Chair, Lyle Okamoto** led a discussion and vote on how the club should handle raffle and medal sales at the show. Costs were gone over and example page was handed out which listed three scenarios for raffle and medal sales. People gave opinions, offered other suggestions and asked questions. The three scenarios were put to a vote of the members as a recommendation to the board. The results were: (1) Keep things the same - 12 votes, (2) separate ticket and medal sales - 11 votes, (3) separate medal sales by subscription only - 3 votes. The results will be discussed at the September Board Meeting.

**NEW BUSINESS: None**

**Raffle Grand Prize:** was won by **Al Lo** - 1920 dos pesos Mexican Gold Meeting adjourned at 9:59 PM.

### AT THE SEP. 24<sup>TH</sup> BOARD MEETING

**Vice-President, Ryan Johnson** called the board meeting to order at 8:06 pm. He welcomed 7 seated members and three guests, Members, **Ron Ishizaki, Don Ehlers and Briita Ehlers**. A quorum was not present. **Recording Secretary, Allison Paker** read the minutes from the September 12, 2007 General Meeting, which were approved as read. **Corresponding Secretary, Al Lo** gave **Bourse Chair, Ray Johnson** some returned bourse apps and then passed around the 50-year Membership Medal received from CSNA. **Historian, Sally Johnson** reported that **Member, Grace Richmond** had passed away on July 17<sup>th</sup> and **Life Member and Member of the SJCC Hall of Fame, Al Mandell** had passed away on June 30<sup>th</sup>. **Al Lo** will send sympathy cards to both

families. **Program Chair, Ryan Johnson** announced that the October meeting will be Giant Auction and Hot Dog Night. **Medals Chair, Lyle Okamoto** reported that he has received several orders for the SJCC/ANA medals before they are melted. Lyle needs a list of the raffle prizes for the show tickets. **Webmaster, Sally Johnson** reported that the website has been updated to include Liberty Numismatic Society's book sale.

**OLD BUSINESS: Board Member, Lyle Okamoto** opened a discussion on the status of show medals and ticket sales and the results of the poll from the general meeting. Lyle reports that the club has approximately 200 pounds of leftover medals from previous years. It was also brought up that the accounting for the number of medals sold with tickets and the number sold at the front desk has been a problem in past years. After a long discussion the board recommended that we separate the sales of raffle tickets from the sale of club medals. The board recommended that the raffle tickets be sold for \$1 each or six for \$5 and Lyle will suggest a price for the medals. This way each program will be self-sustaining and profit and loss will be more evident for each. Lyle thought the number of medals would be between 300 and 400 of each type. Since there was not a quorum present the board couldn't vote on the proposals.

**NEW BUSINESS: Ray** distributed new pages for the board members books and gave binders to the new members.

### SHOW BUSINESS:

**Bourse Chair, Ray Johnson** and **Historian, Sally Johnson** will be visiting the show site at the fair grounds to refine the floor layout. Ray reported that he has received bourse apps from about 35 dealers and the apps are coming in at a steady rate. The first tier discount cut-off date was moved from September 15 to October 15. Meeting adjourned at 10:10 PM
