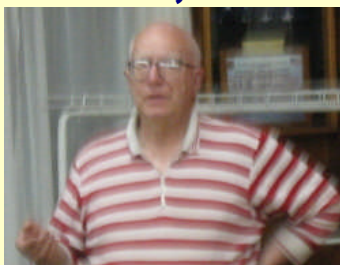

AT THE JUNE 22ND BOARD MEETING

President, Ryan Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:43 PM. **Ryan** welcomed everyone to the meeting. There were thirteen board members present and two guests **Ron Ishizaki** and **Renee Menzes**. **Vice President, Bill Hurja** was absent. **Recording Secretary, Lyle Okamoto** read the minutes to the Wednesday, June 10, 2009, SJCC General Meeting. The minutes were approved as read. **Corresponding Secretary, Al Lo** received the usual club newsletters, P.O. Box receipt notice, official ANA voting ballot, and four bourse applications returned. On the official ANA voting ballot, a motion was made to vote for the incumbent candidates. **Ed Sins** seconded. The motion passed. **Treasurer, Ray Johnson** reported on the financial status of the club. The SJCC Banquet expenses have all been paid. The American Legion Hall rental is paid through April 2010. Due to a misunderstanding, the American Legion returned our \$900 check in return for a \$1200 check from **Treasurer, Ray**

Johnson. There was a misunderstanding in the way the rental agreement was written. The American Legion Hall rents for \$75/month for a one year paid contract, not \$50/month as was thought. **Historian, Sally Johnson** has photos of speaker **Ed Sins** at our June SJCC General Meeting. **Medals Chair, Gordon Stubbs** reported that we have 60 unsold, numbered 2009 silver medals and 14 unsold, unnumbered 2009 silver medals. **Gordon** favored selling future SJCC medals by subscription. **Gordon** also asked that a notice be placed in the club newsletter for all silver medal buyers to buy their silver medals soon. A discussion about the SJCC medals program ensued. **Ed Sins** passed out a cost break down of our medals. **Ed** moved to approach the next SJCC medal by subscription. **Sally Johnson** seconded. The motion passed. **Medals Chair, Gordon Stubbs** also noted that eleven oxidized golden bronze 2009 SJCC medals were used for President's Medal awards. Ten oxidized copper 2009 SJCC medals were used for judging/exhibitor awards. Five aluminum 2009 SJCC medals are left over in inventory. **Gordon** gave **Exhibit Chair, Keith Scott** the needed judging/exhibitor medals today. **Ray Johnson** noted that we still have about seventy, 6-hole Capital Plastics holders available for Presidential Sets. He has another six generic holders for sale for \$17.50 each. **Picnic Chair, Keith Scott** reported that the earliest date available to have our picnic is Sunday, August 2. Other available dates include Saturday, August 15, and Saturday, August 29. **Keith** motioned for Saturday, August 15, as our picnic date. **Richard Shusterman** seconded. The motion passed. **Ed Sins** motioned for Sunday, August 2, as a back-up date. **Ray Johnson** seconded. The motion passed. A discussion about the picnic ensued. **Ron Ishizaki** started the picnic reservation system years ago. The few dollars paid was not as much about paying for the food as it was to make people have a financial commitment and being able to by the right amount of food. The reservation payment is non-refundable. The price for our picnic will be \$3 per adult and free for kids. **Ron** also gave a report on the picnic game equipment. **Youth Advisor, Sally Johnson** noted that next meeting is Youth Night. **Ray Johnson** will speak on "Paper." **Youth President, Evan Menzes** will help run the meeting. **Newsletter Editor, Ray Johnson** reported nothing new. **Librarian, Ed Sins** reported nothing new with the club library. **Membership Chair, Ed Sins** asked for dues-paying members to pay their dues.
