amount spent on prizes since drawing ticket sales were down. Only \$180 in drawing tickets was sold last month.

OLD BUSINESS: **Fred Davis** spoke with **Tom French** who wants to rent twenty display cases for his APIC Western Show. **Tom** wants to pick up the display cases a day earlier, on August 11, in order to get the case to Reno on time. **Fred** asked for a copy of our case rental form. There was a discussion over whether such a form existed and where one could be obtained. **Fred** remembered seeing such a form a while back. Our display case rental fee will be \$10/case. **Martha** and **Fred Davis** completed the annual audit. **Fred** handed out the SJCC Audit Report. The period under audit was from May 2008 through April 2009. The records were consistent with the bank statements and receipts, with the following anomalies. There were no receipts for two flea market equipment purchases made by **Ron Ishizaki**. There was a small discrepancy over the money collected and the money reported from visiting dealers, \$210 collected versus \$240 reported. There was a \$50.11 bill from El Rancho Steakhouse, dated January 10, 2009. **Sally Johnson** explained in setting up the breakfast that four of us from the set-up committee went there to meet with the waitress; we tried their food and looked at the size and location of the restaurant including their service before set-up day. **Martha Davis** then thanked **Treasurer, Ray Johnson** for a great job on keeping the Treasury records organized and the way everything was dated according to check numbers helped to verify things more easily.

NEW BUSINESS: none

SHOW BUSINESS: Our 2010 show sold out on July 18. Dealers were reported as being happy with our new venue at the **Double Tree Hotel**. There is one dealer on our waiting list for an 8' straight table and four dealers on our waiting list for a corner table. There will be only dealer tables in the room. The registration and club tables will be out in the foyer. Sixty one dealers, including one table-sharing dealer have signed-up. Additional income should be received for display case and lamp rentals, drawing ticket sales, and admission fees. So far, 59 display cases and 18 lamps have been rented. We will charge admission this year, with a \$1 discount for those with any show advertising. Advertising revenue has been received for ads in our show program. This ad revenue should pay for our show programs completely.

The hall at the Double Tree Hotel is on schedule and the security costs are being worked on by **Ray Johnson** who will meet with **Lee Wilson** to arrange security. There will be no set-up breakfast. The Double Tree Hotel will set-up the tables and chairs. They also will cover and skirt the tables for us. The Banquet Room has been reserved upstairs at the Double Tree Hotel. **Ray Johnson** needs to coordinate with **Al Lo** for the CSNA Banquet. The Double Tree Hotel requires 85 hotel nights be used at our show. **Ray Johnson** reported that we will probably meet that number. Our special show rate is \$89/night plus \$5 overnight parking. Guest parking will be \$3/day. A discussion about our show drawing ensued. Suggestions for a 50/50 Drawing, an All-Gold Drawing, and silver Eagle prizes were discussed. **Fred Davis** mentioned a show check list for our club chairs that was originally brought up a couple of months ago. **Bill Hurja** volunteered to write the check lists. **Bill** will email the lists to everyone on the board for review and suggestions for improvement. **Gordon Stubbs** volunteered to account for the front desk sales. **Gordon** also reported that we have about 60-70 left over numbered silver medals. **Ray Johnson** then suggested that a 2 oz. silver medal be made for our show drawing prize. **Ray** also suggested that 2 oz. uniface silver medals could be used by our club for a number of different purposes. **Gordon** will speak to **Lee Kuntz** at Masterpiece Medallions about 2 oz. silver medals and stock dies. **Ray Johnson** passed out updated information sheets for our board member's white binders. **Sally Johnson** moved for adjournment. There were multiple seconds. The motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 9:08 PM.
