**Nominations
for the
Ron Miller Memorial
Award**

Northern California Numismatic Association (NCNA) is now taking nominations thru July 1st for the "Ron Miller Memorial Award."

Eligibility:

1. Any active coin hobbyist residing within California at least five (5) full years prior with a verified record of service and support – significant and substantial involvement and interest – in numismatics may be nominated.
2. Membership in the Association shall not be a necessary requirement nor restriction; however, in the selection of recipients, those current Association members nominated may have preference over non-members or past members.
3. The Miller Medal shall be bestowed upon only individuals including husband and wife acting together, but not organization nor groups.
4. No posthumous nominations shall be submitted nor considered.
5. The criteria shall be: superior, sustained and significant support and service to numismatics and its coin hobby and/or dedication, consistent and meritorious, to numismatic organizations.
