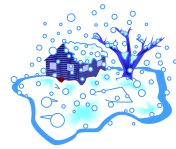

- Corresponding Secretary Lyle Okamoto had the usual mail plus an FTB letter for Treasurer Sally Johnson.
- Treasurer Sally Johnson gave her report.
- Historian Ryan Johnson took pictures of the November General Meeting speaker.
- Program Chair Gordon Stubbs reports Santa will be at the December meeting. We will be having Show & NO Tell.
- Medals Chair Gordon Stubbs reports the medals have been ordered. He hopes to have them in by the December meeting. 88 numbered silver medals were sold and 14 unnumbered. 34 golden bronze & copper medals were sold. 9 extra silver medals were ordered for spare to sell at the show.
- Banquet Chair Brian Daniels reports he will book a Sunday date in May at the Three Flames for our banquet. Sally suggested he go to the website to check the show schedule to avoid a conflict. Brian needs a \$100.00 deposit to reserve the banquet date.
- Youth Chair Ryan Johnson reports Larry B. gave a donation of 4 Whitman blue books.
- Newsletter Editor Allison Paker reports she received a nice e-mail from Dean Alfred about the newsletter. She did also get two requests from people to remove their e-mail from the newsletter list. Ray Johnson requested the Second Harvest donation request run in December's newsletter.
- Webmaster Sally Johnson reports we have 24,552 hits which is up 232 from

last month. Sally received an e-mail from Bill Green who is taking over the Domain Show in March & November. He is also having an East Bay/Concord show. The website has been updated with all the latest show dates.

- Librarian Ed Sins reports he has gotten past due library books turned in. He hopes to find a new Lincoln cents book by David Lang.
  - Membership Ed Sins moved to accept Trieu Nguyen for membership. Ray seconded with Board approval.
  - Old Business- a) Ray Johnson received an e-mail from Scott Western asking if we needed more 3-hole boxes from him. Martha said we have many boxes but need plastic holders for antique bronze & antique copper medals that go in the boxes. Ray will e-mail back that we don't need more. b) Ed Sins had 13 pounds of old club medals that he got \$58 for. He's guessing there's not a lot of interest in back issues.
  - New Business- Sally Johnson received an e-mail from ANA executive director Jeff Shevlin. He would like to be a speaker at our show. CSNA will use the meeting room at 8 am and CES at 10 am. Sally said and others agreed that educational forums need to be advertised better. Suggestions were made as to how to get more people to the speakers.
  - Show Business- a) Bourse Chair Ray Johnson reports the show is sold out. b) Ray went over jobs at the show. We still need someone to 1) transport the trailer to & from Lockheed, 2) bring the equipment from the locker and bring it back after the show, 3) put out the sandwich boards. Announcements will be made at the general meeting to get volunteers. c) Ed Sins asked if wooden nickels have the club information. Sally said yes. Ed asked for a new supply to hand out to people to get people interested in coming to club meetings. d) Ed mentioned there seemed to be an excessively long wait when people came at 10 at the start of the show. Ray responded he had an improvement by processing people in line before the show starts. e) Ed asked about broken cases. Ryan said he would remove them from the trailer and repair them himself during night security. The one with broken glass will need to be taken to a glass shop. f) Keith is building his own display case because of the limitations of standard cases. He plans to set up his exhibit at the show.
