

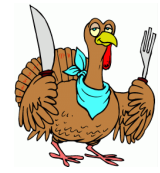

President, Bill Meadows called the meeting to order at 7:39 PM and opened the meeting with 9 seated Board Members and 1 Hall of Fame Member **Ken Barr**. The Meeting was held at Denny's Located on 2077 North First Street, San Jose, CA. **Recording Secretary Ryan Johnson** waived reading the General Meeting minutes. **Treasurer, Sally Johnson** submitted a financial report to the board of directors. **Corresponding Secretary, Lyle Okamoto** reported the usual club correspondence and a letter from **Scott Griffin** announcing a recognition dinner, to be held in conjunction with the Old SF Mint show Feb.22. **Picnic Chair, Keith Scott** stated that he may need a larger budget for the picnic next year. **President Bill Meadows** reported that he will be the speaker for November and will be speaking on the \$2 ½ Gold Eagle. **Youth Advisor, Sally Johnson** reported that two youth were in attendance at the General Meeting. **Newsletter Editor, Ryan Johnson** reported if any member would like anything to be put in the newsletter to let him know. Also we will be doing the food drive during November and December for the Second Harvest Food Bank. **Webmaster, Sally Johnson** reported the website is up to 26,907 hits which us up 216 hits from last month. The website has been updated, and the 1/10th Gold Eagle for the show has been listed on the website. **Librarian, Ed Sins** reported 1 new book, 7th Edition ANA Grading Guide.

Membership Chair, Ed Sins reported that we have one new member; a motion was made to make **Garrett** a member, the motion was seconded with 0-Opposed.

OLD BUSINESS:

Ken Barr discussed the rifle prizes with the board of directors. The statistics since the beginning of the year showing a cost/loss was presented to the board of directors. **Sally Johnson** made a motion to increase the drawing budget by \$100 for one year and to continue to have 10 prizes and at his discretion fluctuate the prizes and we advertise our drawing better to get more people involved. **Ray Johnson** seconded the motion, 1-Opposed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Sally Johnson reported that **Karl Jagenburg** had passed away and she had posted it on our club web site.

SHOW BUSINESS:

Bill Meadows stated that **Al Lo** will not be doing the educational symposium for the San Jose Coin Show in January. **Ray Johnson** reported that speakers have already been lined up for the San Jose Coin Show in January; they will be **Susan Trask**, speaking on Civil War Tokens and **Herb Miles**. ANACS will be taking in submissions for grading. We will be renting 51 cases and 20 lamps, 57 tables have been sold so far and 10 more commitments have been made for tables. Discussion was brought up about the damaged sandwich board signs, and how over half of the signs have been damaged and alternatives to fixing them. It was suggested that after this year we purchase and replace the signs with a lightweight plastic sign with an interchangeable sign. **Ray Johnson** made a motion that we order six frames and twelve signs with a budget not exceed \$3000. The motion was seconded and 1-Opposed. **Sally Johnson** stated that we will be giving out the 2013 Park Quarters, at both the Youth Program and the Educational Symposium Program. **Fred Davis** moved for adjournment. The motion was seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 9:09pm.

Proposed Constitution Changes

These are the proposed constitution changes and will be voted on after being published for two-consecutive meetings.

Article IV. Officers – Section 3. The president, and vice-president, having served two consecutive terms, shall not be eligible for re-election to the same office until after a two year absence from that office.

Article VIII. Duties of Officers – Section 4. The corresponding secretary shall attend to the correspondence of the club, and keeping on file all-important communications and copies of the replies thereto. The corresponding secretary and treasurer shall retain a copy of the key for the Post Office Box. Upon expiration of his/her term of office shall turn over to the successor all books, records, and accessories, of the office taking a receipt therefore.

Article VIII. Duties of Officers – Section 10. The coin show Bourse Chair shall, as a key member of the Show Committee, be responsible for bourse dealer participation at the San Jose Coin Club's Coin & Collectibles Show. He/she will create and maintain a current list of possible bourse dealer participants, mail out or distribute bourse applications, receive bourse applications and maintain an accounting of table type, table location, quantity of cases and lamps, show program advertising, requested advertising literature, etc., turn in and account for all monies received from bourse dealers to the club treasurer, send out bourse confirmations, check in dealers at the show, interface with dealers to answer questions and resolve problems, maintain a continuous liaison with bourse dealers to promote and improve the show. The Bourse Chair shall report, regularly, to the Show General Chair and Board of Directors the status of the bourse and shall make recommendations as needed. It is recommended, but not mandatory, that (1) this position have a duration of five years, so as to maintain a consistent and stable relationship with the bourse dealers, (2) the Bourse Chair's replacement work with him/her for at least six months to a year prior to

assuming full responsibility, and (3) the Bourse Chair's replacement have the means (a computer) to create, produce, and maintain documents and records pertaining to the position. At the end of his/her term of office, he/she shall turn over all club property and records to his/her successor taking a receipt therefore.

Article VIII. Duties of Officers – Section 11. The Web Master (feminine web mistress), also called the system administrator, the author, or the website administrator, is the person responsible for designing, developing, marketing, or maintaining a website. Core responsibilities of the webmaster include the regulation and management of access rights of different users of a web site, the appearance, and setting up of web site navigation. Content placement can be part of a web master's responsibilities; typically, the web master is the agent who reads user feedback and complaints about the site functionality. At the end of his/her term of office, he/she shall turn over all club property and records to his/her successor taking a receipt therefore.
